Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is a worldwide day of fasting and abstinence. "To fast" means eating up to two small meals and one regular meal, with no food in-between meals. The law of fasting binds all those who are between 18 to 59 years of age. Parents, pastors, teachers, and all who accompany younger people in their faith lives can help young children grow in their understanding of the meaning and practice of these penitential traditions. "Abstinence" from meat is also required on Ash Wednesday. Fish is an accepted alternative. This law applies to all who are 14 years of age and older. Women who are pregnant or breastfeeding, and persons with particular medical conditions may be dispensed from these laws.

LENT: An opportunity to embrace a turning point in life.

A fundamental definition for the season of Lent is - a liturgical season for spiritual preparation for the celebration of Easter. The Lenten observances of fasting, prayer and almsgiving are tools to help us with this spiritual exercise. Yet, it is the effort we contribute to these observances that will change our lives. It is only after *fasting* from the unnecessary pleasures of life that we change our bad or selfish habits and come to appreciate the essentials of life. Life becomes more simple, less cluttered by distractions. It is only after spending more time with God in *prayer*, through personal prayer and communal worship (Mass), meditation, praying over scripture and spending more time in devotional prayer, that we come to know God more fully and are more aware that He is ever-present in our lives. And it is only after sharing from our wealth or *almsgiving*, (of our time, talent and treasures), that we appreciate the bounty that we have and how we can contribute to the lives of those in need. All of this summed up is the fruit of our Lenten exercise that not only prepare us for Easter but also leaves a lasting mark on our consciousness and how we live the rest of our lives. It is a turning point, a new beginning, a new you and a new me, making our way on the road to holiness.

It would be our shared hope then, that we don't return to our bad habits and our selfish mindsets or our relaxed prayer life on Easter Monday but rather to hold fast to the positive transformation we've experienced and honour the genuine efforts we put forth and to living a better Christian identity or as the saying goes today to living "the best version of myself".

Another dimension in our spiritual journey through Lent is to join Jesus in the desert. To confront temptation and to face our own demons head on. He will throw temptations our way everyday He will tempt us to give up on our commitment to our Lenten observance, to give into the will of the flesh and social norms that are not a part of who we are called to be or want to be, to lessen the gravity of sin and justify poor choices and put our Christian dignity aside. He will lure us in the ways of laziness with regards to practicing our faith by leading us away from God and Jesus.

Lent is a time of reflection, self-examination, repentance, penance, conversion and preparation which lead us to renewal, an awakening and new life. With these we allow ourselves to give more of our attention to God and strive to live a holy life, as a testimony for all that God is, has done and has given to us.

It is my prayer that each of us take seriously the importance of the forty days of Lent. We know what we need to change in our life and we want desperately to deepen our relationship with God and His Son Jesus. All we must do is make an unwavering commitment to remain faithful to our observances, embrace humility when examining our conscience and life choices, go to confession with sorrow and a desire to "turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel" and celebrate the graces of the sacrament by choosing to never return to old ways.

May God bless you in your Lenten Journey.
