2025 Parish Statistics, Spiritual and Financial Reports

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Corpus Christi Parish,

The Finance Council and I are happy to provide the following reports for your information and review. 2025 has been for our parish a year of change and growth. We have been blessed to welcome a growing number of individuals and families to our parish both as visitors and as new members. We are also encouraged by an increase in requests for sacraments, especially baptisms and weddings, along with inquiries into the Catholic faith by adults.

Financially speaking, we remain committed to being good stewards of the financial gifts entrusted to the parish, which involves both prudence in spending and cutting expenses where possible. The ongoing support of parishioners and friends along with some initial cost-containing efforts have allowed us to end the year 2025 in an almost break-even position, with a very minimal deficit of \$2,136.24.

Completed projects for the past year include the curbing and paving at the entrance of the rectory office. A word of thanks for all donations made specifically in support of this project. The landscaping and gardening at the same site will be completed this spring/summer. We remain committed to the goal of adding \$10,000 each year to our funds on deposit with the diocese for use in future maintenance projects. The 2025 top-up brings this fund up to \$57,431.00.

For 2026 and onward, the Finance Council has been tasked with identifying cost-containing strategies and with compiling a list of forward-looking projects related to maintaining the buildings/property. One of the most pressing of these projects already identified will be providing a permanent solution for our church furnace/heating system so that it will run smoothly and effectively for the upcoming winter.

Another goal for 2026 is to expand the membership of our Finance Council to include more individuals who have a passion for supporting and enhancing the spiritual and temporal good of our community. The Finance Council meets approximately four times a year. If you or anyone you know would like to find out more about being a member, please contact Doug Corbett (Finance Council Chair) or Fr. 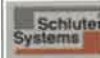
